## Council spending for 2007/2008

The Council recently approved its estimated budget and the precept for 2007/2008.

The Council has made specific provision to provide £5,000 towards the proposed refurbishment of the Chester Avenue (Tom Robinson) Play Area. The Council intends to apply for match funding from the Ribble Valley Borough Council under the new capital initiative. Grants to the Citizens Advice Bureau and Roefield Leisure centre have been budgeted for, together with a significant number of grants or donations to various community and voluntary organizations as well as £2,500 for the Castle Heritage Lottery Scheme.

## A59 Speed limits

The Council has recently been consulted by the Road Safety Engineer from the Lancashire County Council about proposals to introduce a "prohibition of right turn movement" on the A59 road at the Pendle Road junction.

The Council has responded by asking the County Council to consider reducing the speed limits on the dual carriageway to 50mph. This is in the interests of highway safety.
